May 11, 2016

- Incidents** - April, 2016 16 total, 6 medical, 6 structure, 0 natural cover, 0 mva, 1 lift assist, 1 false alarm, 2 hazardous condition
Structure responses - 4 Automatic Aid to DCFD2, 1 mutual aid to TenMile
- Training** - FF1 class (with Explorers) and new FFs continuing. Recent classes were DFPA wildland safety and annual OSHA refresher, vehicle operation and maintenance, SCBA/PPE testing, electric/hybrid vehicle class ongoing.
- Firefighters** - Lost one ff to move, have one new one starting and two moving into area soon who have approached me. 2 of our Explorers are turning 18 and are being signed up. Put two others on "leave" with DPSST, due to work and family they are not able to respond enough. Did a school program with DCSO, USFS, Bay Cities at WellSpring in Roseburg.
- Explorers** - FF1 final performance testing being completed. 6 have passed the PPE test, 90 seconds from street clothes to full PPE and on air..
- Equipment** - New 1080 - Checking on delivery of chassis, no word yet. Actually helped us this year if it goes into July due to audit. Tires for 1030 were backordered, due middle of May. 1080 front tires separating, will replace them in next 2 weeks.
Air system testing completed for year, new contract budgeted will start July 1. Repair of system this month,
Inventory - Added wildland gear - helmets, goggles, gloves
- Facility** - Fire hydrant installed by Cradar, payment tonight. \$8600 was low bid.
Getting more bids on pavement/drainage for next FY.
Will get washer in next few weeks, around \$600.
Haz Mat/fuel disclosure to State completed. Eye wash changed, extinguishers checked.
Yard brushhogged, will spray weeds and tree removal this month.
- Accounting -Office**
Received another small tax check this month, still appear on schedule for budgeted amount
Continued communication with Dept. of Revenue, had them evaluate our Budget documents and appropriations. Will have them review all of it when the resolution is done and budget hearing completed. Have LB1 and LB50 done, next budget hearing June 8 at 6:30 pm.
Met with Wheeler over a few issues and will have an appointment to get all grant money into the right funds, and line items straightened out after June 1 but before FY year end.
Will get VFA grant again this year, \$16436 total, 50/50 split. Good for purchases made from last October on.
- Miscellaneous** - SDAO/SDIS - May 17th meeting in Roseburg with SDAO, 9 to 11am. Will include ethics training. I have registered, if someone else wants to go that would be great. We will be at 6% discount for our Best Practices. Workers Comp bill will be in any day, expect an 18% raise on the Volunteer FF part, budgeted for that. Still less than Liberty Mutual before.
Parade/Cleanup Day this weekend. We will have an active part. 9 to 4pm or so. Work for food.
