

CHIEF'S MINUTE(s)

October 12, 2016

- Incidents** - September, 2016 12 total, 7 medical, 2 structure, 3 natural cover, 0 mva, 0 public assists, Fire danger rated at "Low". All use restrictions off, permits required only for slash burns. Structure fires were mutual aid to Tenmile and Douglas 2.
- Training** - FF1 class (with Explorers) continuing. UCC trailer still to be here this month. Recent training has been search and rescue, hose streams and practices, fire behavior, rope rescue inventory and review.
- Firefighters** - Injured firefighter released to full duty. WC process completed. Will be conducting fire prevention training for local schools this week. One volunteer, one explorer were involved in 911 flag program at VA.
- Explorers** - Continue to work towards FF1 certification, one disciplinary issue pending investigation.
- Equipment** - New 1080 - Jonathan Brunton visited factory, says they are on schedule to complete as contracted (270 days) We are at 250 now. Annual pump tests were completed and bills are in this month's finances.
- Inventory** - Continued VFA equipment purchase and other budgeted items. Received rain gear, sensor for 4 gas monitor, name tags for crew members, PPE boots, SCBA mask parts for in house repair, ordered fire pump for VFA after bidding and comparisons.
- Facility** - Constructed additional PPE hanging area for explorers and ffs. Purchased storage cabinets for upstairs as budgeted.
- Accounting -Office** - In lieu of Audit and payment submitted to Secretary of State. Budget paperwork to County Sept. 9. Received and updating SDAO/SDIS liability insurance for next year - due Nov 11th. Worked with SDIS during Bob's WC case. Looked at and modified the Whistleblower sample policy and will forward to Board/Jerry for next month meeting.
- Miscellaneous** - Best practices due November 1st.
