May, 2018

Incidents – April, 2018 12 total, 5 medical, 1 structure, 1 mva, 2 public assist, 2 natural cover/smoke, 1 haz mat. One structure fire was mutual aid to Camas Valley w/ 1061.

Training – Training for the month included DFPA annual refresher, Driver Training/Safety, PPE drills, vehicle maintenance and operation. Crews attended training in Roseburg at Windmill Inn site for firefighter safety/rapid intervention, and scheduled for more this month.

Firefighters - Continuing online courses, blood borne pathogens, defensive driving, and Incident Command. Focus still is finishing any pending FF1 training classes and Driver/Operator development along with associated policy/procedures. 2 Explorers filled out applications as volunteers and FF1 certification pending. Participated in the Lookingglass Clean Up day festivities. Continue to recertify Emergency Medical Responders with the State.

Explorers - Participated in all ff training and public education/events.

Equipment - 1090 – Radio installed, multiple warning devices received and will install what is needed.
1081 – Replacing one warning light that burned out.
1030 – emergency lighting repaired.

Inventory - IT inventory completed and forwarded to Director Harris

Facility Mowed and brush hogged, will do again this month as well as weed spraying.

Office/Admin - SDIS Workman's Comp update for 18/19 finished. Two budget meetings held and approved budget posted. Will notice and complete LB1 form for budget hearing June 13 at 6:30 pm.
VFA Grant for 2018/19 submitted on time, included in new budget.
VFA check for \$8575 and two rebates from SDAO/SDIS received and deposited by Director Starns
Contacted by our old collection(CSO) agency and lawyers (Speer-Hoyt). Will keep our contract with CSO open and not continue with Speer-Hoyt with Board approval..

Miscellaneous - Vendor for thermal imaging camera came March 16 for demo and estimate. Will return this Thursday, we will consider this camera for purchase as part of the VFA grant if received. Continued meeting with UBWA and contact with State Fire Marshal and contractor for Lookingglass School construction issues. Flow tested all District fire hydrants, some maintenance needed and will follow up. ISO paperwork continuing, will be about 2 more months to submit for evaluation.
