

CHIEF'S MINUTE(s)

October 11, 2017

- Incidents** – September, 2017 14 total, 3 medical, 1 structure, 6 natural cover, 3 mva, 1 public assist, 0 illegal burn . One structure fire was mutual aid to Winston, 2nd alarm at Roseburg Forest Products. DFPA went to Extreme fire danger, use restrictions increased but fire season closes tonight October 11th at midnight. Safe but unrestricted burning allowed. Significant incidents were the Prairie Horse Fire which counts as one incident but we responded over the last week of August and into September, and Tenmile MVA .
Tenmile School Fire today, 2nd alarm. 1061 and 1030.
- Training** – Training for the month included hose testing (2 nights), EMR/medical, and ventilation. Fire Prevention month – Theme “Every second counts, know two ways out”. LKglass school here 10/10/2017
- Firefighters** - FF 1 applications filed with DPSST. Registered EMRs with Oregon Health. Paying tonight. Chief Williams retiring Oct 30th, Tom Johnson December 30th. Necessitates new organization and positions for Ops Manual and your consideration. Two new ff recruits are filling out paperwork and in background check.
- Explorers** - Continue to work towards FF1 certification. Two additional explorers turned 18, moving up. Mike Prowell back to Marines for 3 months. Assisted with Lookingglass school Day.
- Equipment** - 1031 had repairs completed at cost of almost \$5000. No leaks, works well. We also self repaired one additional fitting that rusted through. Repair budget for year done. Billed by accident for Tenmile engine repair.
Inventory - More hose from VFA program in, working on 1081 hose bed fabrication here. Spoke with VP Smith about inventory of units this week. Bills for turnouts and wildland shirts paid, \$4000 plus.
- Facility** - Fire hydrant supply line repaired by UBWA, billed to Cradar. Grange donated new tables and are in.
- Office/Admin** - Delivered self audit for FY 16-17 September 20th to State, paid bill on line. Done for year. More money for start of FY 17-18 than budgeted (\$74,000 vs \$35,000 general fund and within \$123,000 in equipment fund) Background check for FF1 candidate. Continued payments and registering of recent EMR graduates through Oregon Health. Received annual insurance update packet and Best Practices from SDAO. (Discussion of both) Due mid November, no issues meeting that. Submitted reimbursement packet to DFPA for Horse Prairie Fire. \$14,000 plus total, \$5000 for 1081 vehicle and rest for labor.

- Miscellaneous** - More address signs out to Diamond Heights Firewise program and others. Request for 50 engines from California 10/11/2017.
